Yes, all are but memories, but we will never fail to share her ideals wherever we are and lift her to greatness.







THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES AND THE UNIVERSITY PRESIDENT

THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES is by law the highest governing body of the University, whose chief concern is the making of high policy which the University President is duty-bound to implement. The President of the University, as a creature and agent of the Board of Trustees and by virtue of his office, is the highest executive officer and leader of the University, who must operate administratively within the policy framework set up by the Board of Trustees.

A progressive and enlightened Board of Trustees does not concern itself with the administration of the campus. That job it has given to the University President, whom it has carefully chosen, theoretically, over a number of capable candidates.

If the University President is no good, he will bungle the administration of the University, and the choice of the Board of Trustees has proved to be a mistake. But if the Board of Trustees has chosen the right kind of President — academically qualified, versed in curricular substance and direction, administratively experienced, progressively oriented, schooled in the great liberal tradition, courageous to blaze unpopular trails, strong in character, discerning in intellect, concerned with the finances as well as the campus and faculty developments — then the Board of Trustees has chosen wisely, and has well placed in that person the necessary confidence to administer with great freedom to make the University move.



THE MASTER of Arts in Education program is designed to provide advanced study and research for the purpose of extending the competence of classroom teachers, school administrators and guidance counselors; to increase depth of insight into educational problems, and to provide the first graduate degree for persons anticipating advanced graduate study in education. The Master of Arts in English course is designed for students interested in new perspectives in English literature; in the place and use of English language and literature in the Philippines; and in training in the linguistic approach to the teaching of English. The Master of Business Administration program provides opportunities for mature students and professionals in business, industry and education to grow professionally and to better qualify as managers, administrators, or executives; to acquire better understanding of management activities and the tools necessary to a fruitful career in business; and to obtain advanced training in a field of specialization. THE MASTER of Arts in Education program is designed to provide

M.A. in Ed. — Master of Arts in Education with three fields of specialization: Administration and Supervision; Teaching Theory and Practice; Counseling, Measurement and Evaluation.

M.A. in English — Master of Arts in English with three fields of specialization: Literature; the Structure of the English Langu-age; the Teaching of English as a Second Language.

M.B.A. — Master in Business Administration with three fields of specialization: General Management; Marketing; Finance.

More than seventy students have attained the Master of Arts degree since the opening of the school in 1950. Many of these now occupy leading administrative and supervisory positions in the field of public and private education. The research projects completed for the thesis have added to knowledge and understanding of educational and language problems. New fields of specialization include Modern Mathematics, Counseling and Business. Considerable research in Ilongo as a language in being conducted.


Law

The best legal minds available meet at Central Philippine University, where together, they mould the youth for a dynamic, fearless leadership steeped in Christianity and of excellent legal character. Mentors at CPU are well aware that the youth's potentialities for success in the future are great, given the necessary guidance, attention and the proper training.

A varied program of cultural, recreational and social opportunities is open to the students of the College of Law. Aside from the regular convocations during weedkays, extra effort is made to bring outstanding leaders both local and national, to the campus so they may be introduced to students.

Seminars, debates, oratorical contests and other forensic activities are sponsored by the fraternity with the hope of training the students not only to hurdle the Bar examinations they have to take before they can practice law, but also in enabling them to satisfactorily equipped themselves with the unwritten techniques in the art of advocacy.

Several scholarships are open to deserving students in the University. Upon recommendation of the Dean, excellent and meritorious students in the College of Law are granted free tuition. At the end of the schoolyear, certificates and citations are awarded to the students who



have excelled in the different fields of learning su debating, oratorical contests, scholarship, writing other cultural fields.

Supreme Court Digests, Philippine Reports, latest es of books, in Political, Civil, Commercial, and Crimina Law on Procedure, as well as periodicals such as La Journal and the Official Gazette, are reserved entit the Law Library, for the students in the College of

Established in 1951 by Dr. Burl Alva Slocum, who laid very strong foundations for the College, which enabled it to achieve through the years a degree of national prestige.

In 1954 the first class of four was graduat ed. Presently the College is graduating an average of 100 each year with the four-year agricultural degree.

It is the aim of the College to train studen ts in scientifically developed, up-to-date agricultural methods and to teach them how to use the fir training as farmers, farm managers, teachers, and workers for the various agriculturally related to branches of the government as well as for private industries which sell and distribute agricultural products, equipment and supplies.

Through agricultural research the College app lies the methods of scientific investigation to find answers to pertinent agricultural problems. Th

rough agricultural extension the College endeavors to train off-campus groups of farmers to use mo dern farming techniques. Through an emphasis on deep-rooted spiritual values the College trains students to be better able to serve both God and their fellowmen.

In practice the program of resident instruction overlaps the programs research and extension. As students pursue their chosen curricula they assist with the research of the various agricultural projects. Furthermore, as a requirem ent for the four-year degree students conduct independent projects under the direction of an advisor and prepare formal reports covering the projects. Students often take part in the College's extension program as observers and participants in demonstrations, exhibits, farmers' in stitutes, farm study classes and other extension activities.

The typical entering freshman student in the College of Arts and Sciences is about seventeen or eighteen year old, the graduating senior usually twenty-one or twenty-two. Any educationally qualified student is free to apply for admission. The yearly enrollment in this college is about 450 students. Students in this college live on the campus in dormitories provided by the University or stay in private homes or apart ments.

The general aim of this college is to give each student an education sufficiently broad and liberal to enable him to understand the complex social world structure in which he lives, and to understand himself and re-evaluate his ideas. Upon completion of any of these preparatory curricula of a student may continue in a professional or technical school without loss credit. Another aim of the college is to encourage development of the character which can make intellect constructive and the personality which can make intellect effective. These things are not taught but are caught through the relationship between the student and the members of the faculty.

The college offers curricula leading to the degrees: Bachelor of Arts (General), Bachelor of Arts with a major subject, Bachelor of Science (Pre-Med), Bachelor of Science (Med-Tech), and Bachelor of Science in Chemisty. The Bachelor of Arts curriculum may be so adjusted as to able a student to major in Economics, English, Histo Philosophy, Policial Science, Social Science, and Social Worthead Bachelor of Science curriculum may be so arranged to permit a major in Biology, Chemistry, General Science Mathematics, Nutrition, and Physics.

To be entitled to a Bachelor's degree a student has comply with the following unit requirements in the following areas: (a) English, 18; (b) Foreign Language, 12; Natural Sciences, 15; (d) Mathematics, 6; (e) Social Science 21; (f) Free Elective, 6; (g) Physical Education, 4; (h) Region and Ethics, 6; (i) ROTC, 6. In addition to these, least a year's residence or at least one full school year whis equivalent to no less than 30 units of credits is required for graduation in the college before granting the degree.

The Faculty of Arts and Sciences, a good number was Master's degree, numbers more than 80 and the numb of courses offered to undergraduates is normally more than 250.

In 1936, the title of Associate in Commercial Science was conferred for the first time on five students.

The Junior year was added in 1940 and before the senior year could be opened, the Second World War broke out.

In 1945, the college resumed operations at the Old Baptist Student Center in La Paz. The Junior College of Commerce became a full-pledged College of Commerce in 1946. In 1947, five students were graduated with the degree of Bachelor of Science in Commerce.

Today, Accounting, Business Administration, Economics, and Finance are offered as areas of specialization in response to the needs of the business community.



e professional curricula are based on broad and liberal foundars in arts and sciences, competence in the special subjects teaers must teach, and theoretical and practical professional training. The aim is not merely to prepare teachers for the academic diprofessional responsibilities but also to turn out educators with hight into educational problems. The completion of any one the professional curricula leads to the first professional degree either elementary education or secondary education.

The Bachelor of Science in Education degree-programs in tude majors in: Agriculture, Biology, Chemistry, Economics, nglish, General Science, History, Home Economics, Mathematics, hysical Education, and Physics. The Bachelor of Science in Tementary Education degree programs offer majors in: Home conomics and Physical Education. Authority to grant the BSE r the BSEEd degrees with majors in Pilipino and Music Education and Certificate in Teaching has been applied for and is in the processing stage. Holders of bachelor's degrees other than hose in education or elementary education may work for the ertificate in Teaching diploma. This will enable them to meet equirements of the Bureau of Public Schools and other institu-

tions of learning for qualification to teach in their specialized, professional fields.

The formal training and academic disciplines are enriched by seminars, workshops, consultations conducted by Visiting lecturers, qualified Peace Corps Volunteers, AID specialists, UNESCO consultants, Columbo Plan representatives and scholars and scientists from West European embassies who have either been invited by the university and college or been offered by their governments on some cultural exchange plan.

This is as it should be: the teacher is at the frontier of humanity's effort to push back ignorance and superstition. On his shoulders rest the responsibility for insuring that the child is guided well in his first contact with learning. The kind of citizens we will have in the future will be determined by the quality of teachers we have now. To meet this challenging task — probably more challenging than any other profession's — the teacher will be forced to call on his human resources, compassion and concern for the child. He knows his work reaches out beyond the present. In the words of Henry Adams, "A teacher affects eternity. He can never tell where his influence stops."

This is the kind of teacher we aim to turn out in the College of Education.



THEOLOGICAL education began at Central Philippine University in 1922 with a course entitled Special Bible Course, outlined by Dr. Alton Ezra Bigelow. In 1935 the department of theology was developed into the School of Theology of Central Philippine College and Dr. Bigelow became the first dean. In 1905 the Baptist Missionary Training School for women was organized with Miss Anna V. Johnson as principal. In 1938 the School of Theology and the Baptist Missionary Training School were officially merged and the classes became co-educational.

In 1962, because the courses had become almost identical for men and women, except possibly in the choice of "areas of intensification," it was decided that one degree only should be granted — that of Bachelor of Theology.

The College of Theology at Central Philppine University has a unique role. It is the only school of its kind within the area of the Convention of the Philippine Baptist Churches where churches may send their candidates for training for the ministry. It seeks to increase the ability of such individuals to assume places of responsible leadership in the life and work of evangelical churches and their related organizations.

All Christian leaders should possess high competency in dealing with Christian truth as revealed in the Bible and supremely in Jesus Christ. In addition to promoting a thorough knowledge of the Bible, the school purposes to encourage its students to obtain a keen and broad understanding of human nature, of the principles of education and growth, and of the facts and ways of Christian experience.




MISS NONA SUAREZ DOMINADO Principal — University High School.

The University High School celebrates its Golden Jubilee this year. It was organized in 1917 and graduated its first class of seventeen students in 1921. Since then it has increased its enrollment to over 800 students.

The high school library has up-to-date facilities which include a book collection of 3,252 volumes, fifteen periodicals, a special collection of vocational books and pamphlets, and children's literature shelved in a small audio-visual room.

In 1957 the 2-2 plan was implemented with emphasis on developing moral character and providing a well-balanced education to meet the needs of the students. School organizations include in their program of activities—citizenship training, camping, fellowship meetings, and community services designed to develop in them active and functional leadership in preparation for ideal Christian living.

The church, a worshipful place on the campus, blends Bible Study and stirring choir anthems and other forms of worship to satisfy one's thirst for spiritual things.












Sunday School Teachers

Though a female dormitory, Johnson caters for all male theologians who in turn just love to be with the girls during "chow time", the time when the true dorm spirit is noisily evident.


For many years Johnson residents have had to share the lights with mosquitoes and other insects, but because their third floor dormitory is now screened, studying is not disturbed.




Dear friends,
